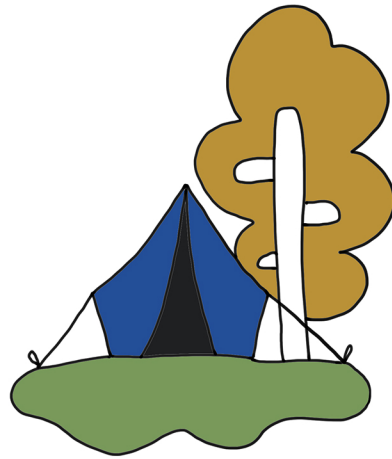


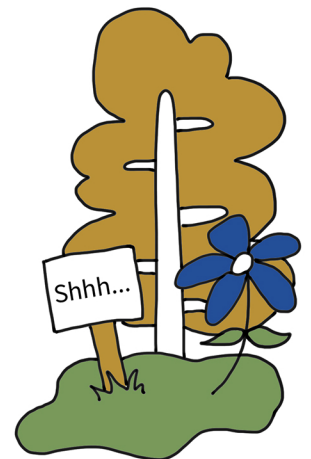
The Åland right of public access is not same as in Sweden and Finland:



You can move freely on foot, by bike and kayaks. Avoid private plots, piers and cultivated land. Always close gates after you.



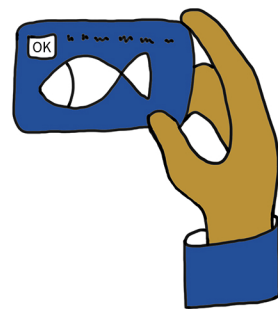
Campsites, holiday villages and guest harbors. are recommended for overnight stays, You are allowed to sit down for a break. If it is not possible to ask the landowner's permission, then it is allowed to camp with single tents for 24 hours made with regard to domestic peace. That means that you shall have a sufficient distance from buildings and with regard to the place in general.



It is forbidden to harm nature or disturb those who own the ground. The same applies to to spend the night in a boat.



Do not leave rubbish behind in nature, leave it to the nearest waste station. Sort your waste.



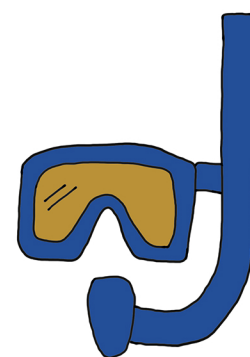
Spin fishing is not included in the right of public access. To fish you should first buy a fishing license for the waters you want to fish on. Fishing licenses are sold by cottage hosts, online and at the tourist information. During the period April 15 to June 15, it is forbidden to fish from the shore with a spinning rod or with a lure. The ban is intended to protect nesting seabirds.



Berries and mushrooms may be picked for your own needs, but not plants as per teams are protected, such as orchids.



According to law, open fire may not be settled in the land without the permission of the landowners. Fire can destroy rocks forever. In case of fire, call 112!



For diving with tubes you must have permission of the Åland Provincial Government, tel. +358 18 25 000.
